Photo Collage with a Difference

Aim: To arrange a few photographs on a page Creatively

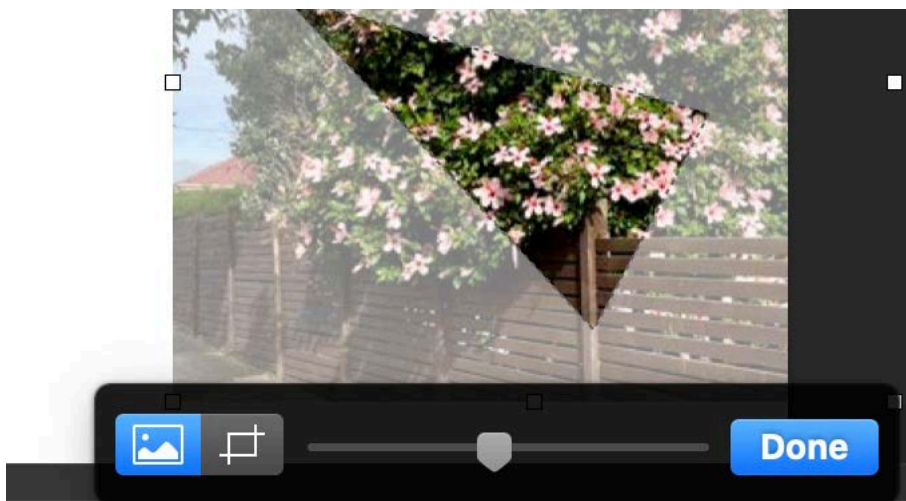
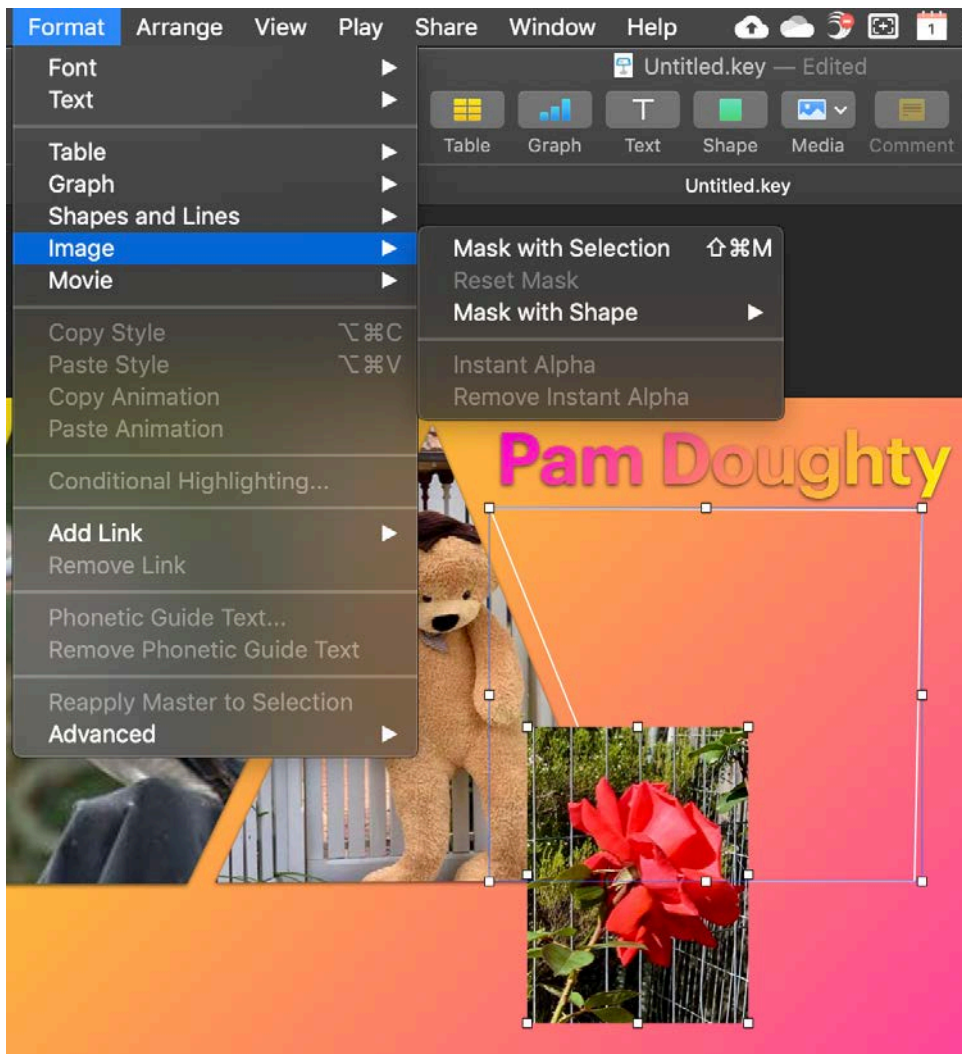


The above image was put together in Keynote however I could have achieved the same result in Pages or Numbers using the technique BRIEFLY outlined below.

The procedure used is Format > Image > Mask with Selection

I believe the EASIEST way to use this feature is:

- Use the Pen shape tool to draw a shape,
- Select **Choose...** from the **Insert** menu to add a photograph to the page,
- Select the photograph AND the shape, and then
- Format > Image > Mask with Selection.



You will need to move your photograph over the shape and adjust the controls until your shape masks the photograph appropriately.

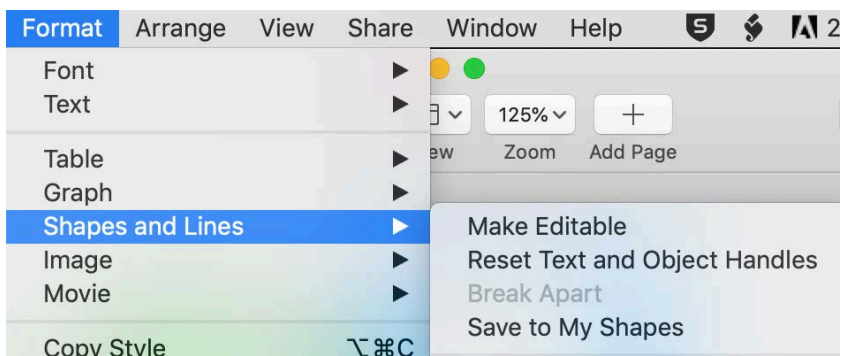
When you are happy click Done.

ANOTHER WAY

Start with the shape nearest to the one you need.



Select the shape then go to Format > Shape and Lines > Make Editable



Move any of the 'coloured dots' until the shape is the way you want it.

Move your Pages or Keynote document to one side of your screen and Open Photos so you can see the images in an album of your choice.

With the shape selected in Pages or Keynote drag your image from Photos directly over the selected shape. As above adjust the controls so the image fits into the shape.
