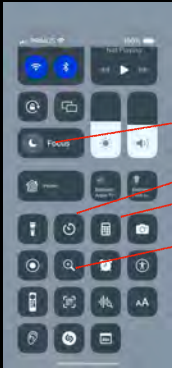

- Magnifier

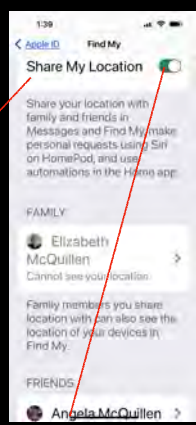
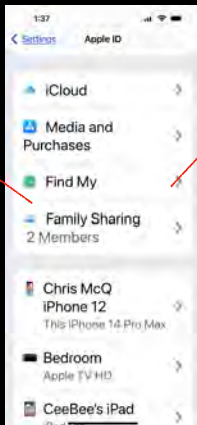
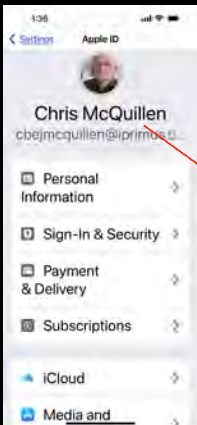

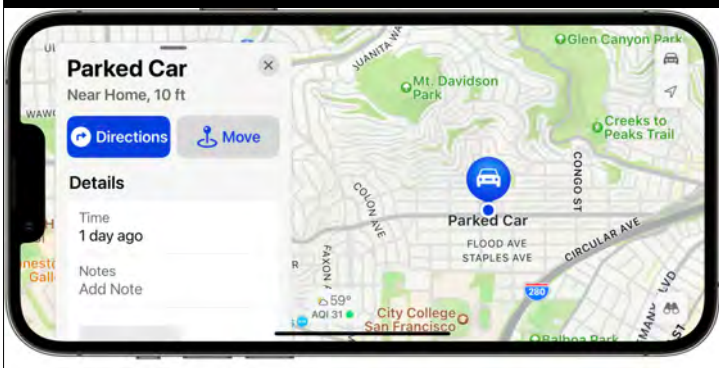




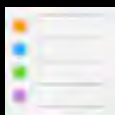
How the iPhone Helps with Forgetfulness (memory prompting)

Reminders

Add a reminder with Siri

You can ask Siri to schedule a reminder for you on your iOS device or your Apple Watch.*

Here are a few examples:

- "Remind me to feed the dog every day at 7.30 a.m."
- "Remind me when I get home to check the mail."
- "Remind me when I leave here to stop by the supermarket."
- "Remind me tomorrow at 3.00 p.m. to call Tara."

Add your home and work addresses to your card in Contacts to allow Siri to help you set location-based reminders.

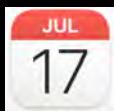


Reminders App

If you're forgetful, Apple's Reminders app can make your life easier—no more missed appointments or forgetting to take time critical medications .

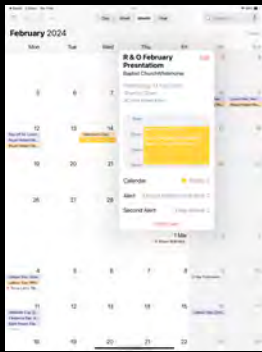

Calendars

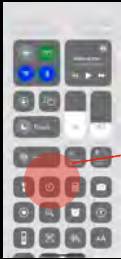
I use calendars for appointments and commitments. I also use it to remind me to pay utilities and monthly, quarterly or annual payments.

Simplest Reminder- Timers

In your Control Centre there is a timer which you can set to any duration and it will give an alarm when it times out

Sign documents

Electronic signatures are becoming an acceptable norm for business contracts and many other kinds of documents. You can sign a signature easily within the Mail app using the markup option on your iPhone. Open the document from the Mail app on your iPhone.

In the email tap on the attached and downloaded document you want to sign.

Scroll through and find the place that requires a signature.

Tap the mark-up symbol.

An assortment of pen options will appear, along with a plus sign.

Select the plus sign and then the signature option will appear.

A screen will open that allows you to use your finger to sign your name. When you finish writing your signature, click done.

You can then place your signature precisely where you want it on the document.

Scan a Document in Notes

Apple includes a feature in Notes that allows you to quickly scan all kinds of documents so you can keep track of everything from receipts to recipes and photos.

The Document Scanner detects the edges of a document, aligns things properly, and removes all glare and tilt so you get a clean scan every time.

Scan a Document in Notes

Open the Notes App

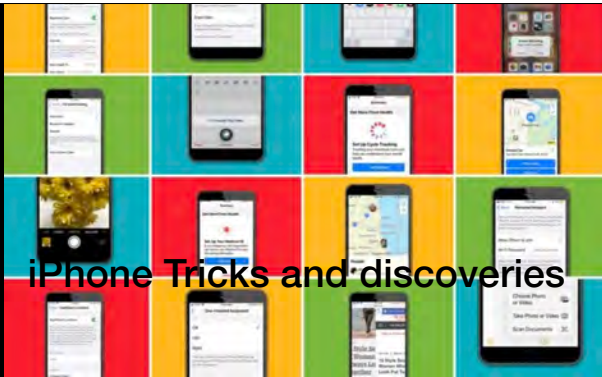
Place the document under the iPhone.

Frame and focus the document and move the iPhone so that the yellow and white crosses are perfectly aligned

Tap the camera icon

Tap scan Documents

After capture, save the document



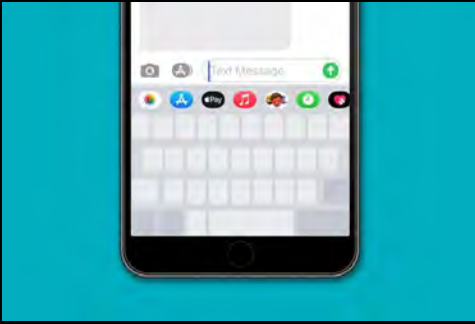
‘ Make your iPhone keyboard function as a trackpad

If you've ever tried to move your cursor in a text only to find yourself stabbing at your phone's screen with your finger, you need a trackpad on your phone. This is one of the iPhone tips and tricks that will

You can turn your iPhone into a trackpad.

Just start typing in an email or text message, then press and hold a finger on the space bar on your iPhone's keyboard. When you do this, the other keys will fade to gray, and you can use the area as a trackpad.

‘ Useful Hidden iPhone tricks



iPhone Voice Recorder

Turning your iPhone into a recording device is simple. Open the Voice Memos app and press the red Record button. It will then record the audio of what is going on, much like a tape recorder does. Tap the red button again to finish the recording, then title it and save it as desired.

iPHONE CAPS LOCK KEY

When you first look at the iPhone keyboard that pops up on your screen, it's noticeably missing a Caps Lock key. However, all you have to do is double-tap the Shift key, and it will turn into a Caps Lock key. Use it any time you need to write in all capital letters, so you don't have to press the Shift key for each letter.

Your iPhone is a Magnifying Glass

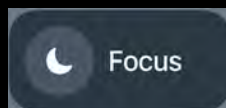
To access this iPhone trick, open the Control Center and simply click on the Magnifier to open it.

To adjust the magnification, move the slider that should then appear on the screen.

CALCULATOR BACK SPACE.

You do not have to press clear and start over if you accidentally press a wrong number. It seems so once you've entered a lot of numbers or started your calculations on the app. However, if you swipe to the left on the area where the numbers are displayed, the last number will be deleted without erasing the rest of your work.

iPhone's Focus



Focus can help you manage the interaction with people via your phone with iOS15 and later.

You can also turn on Focus from Control Centre. Simply open Control Centre on your iPhone, then touch and hold Focus. It will bring up the full menu for you to choose the Focus you want to adjust.

Now, choose one of the Focus options:

Do Not Disturb,

Driving,

Personal,

Sleep or Work. Tap on the one that most closely meets your needs; then you can customise which people and apps you want to receive notifications from during your Focus period.

iPhone Camera hidden tricks.



Shoot bursts of photos

You can easily use the phone's camera to shoot bursts of photos.

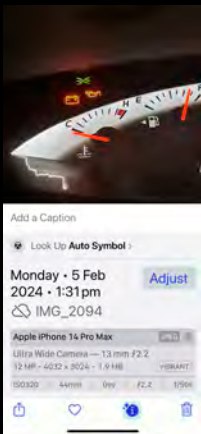
On iPhone X and earlier models, just hold down the camera app's shutter button.

On iPhone XS, iPhone XR and later models, swipe the shutter button to the left. In either scenario, simply lift your finger to stop shooting bursts.

SYMBOL TRICKS IN iOS 17

This is a new feature in iOS 17. If you see a warning light/symbol on the car's dashboard and have no clue what it/they mean, then do this.

Take a photo of the warning lights or symbols and swipe it up. Then tap on the Look Up Auto Symbol option. The Visual Look Up tool will instantly identify the warning lights/symbols and provide you with the necessary information. Besides the automobile symbols, you can identify laundry codes.



IDENTIFY OBJECTS IN PHOTOS

Search with Google Lens.

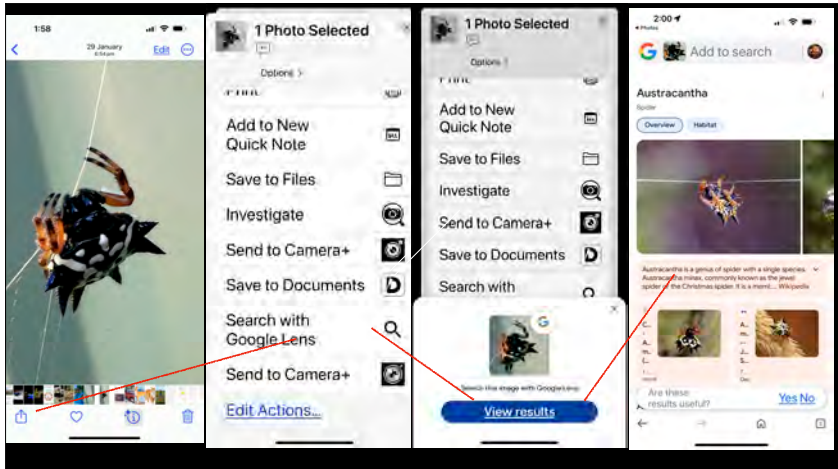
Select any photo in Photos library.

Force Restart an iPhone X to 15

One that does not have a home button.

Briefly press the volume + button (up) and let it go

Briefly press the volume - button (down) and let it go

Press the right hand side button

Then slide the screen displayed power button in the off direction

The iphone will shutdown

Restart by pressing and holding the side key and then enter your Passcode
